- Clients will not understand the COVID virus

- Due to the personal care required, employees will not be able to social distance while providing care
- We will be cleaning constantly but that comes with no guarantees
- The only way we can be successful is with all of us working together
- There will be unique challenges we will face together every day
- Expect the Unexpected
